Puget Sound Race for the Cure**

Four bake sales, hundreds of ribbon sales, a garage sale, two ice cream socials and a silent auction, plus the standard “will you sponsor me” requests netted more than \$10,500 in contributions for the Group Health Credit Union Race for the Cure team this year. Ninety GHCU staff, friends and family turned out on June 7 to walk or run in the 5K Race—the largest team the credit union has had in its many years of participating.

Despite the credit union’s modest size (just over 100 employees), GHCU was the number two corporate team in funds raised, a number which is a source of great pride to Team Captain Meghin Margel.

Says Margel, “We are a small, not-for profit credit union with a big heart. Dollar by dollar we earned these donations because we believe in the importance of breast cancer research and finding a cure for this disease that touches the friends and families of our employees and members.
